The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Mauritius to the United Nations
honour to refer to the latter's communication No. CLCS.53.2010.LOS (Continental Shelf
Notification) dated 28 July 2010 relating to the submission made by the Republic of

the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Mauritius had in its Note 143.2009/10
informed the Secretary-General of the United Nations that it would make its own
observations on the submission made by the Republic of Maldives. In this regard, the
Permanent Mission wishes to inform the Secretary-General that following discussions
between the Republic of Mauritius and the Republic of Maldives, the Republic of
Maldives had in October 2010 agreed with the Republic of Mauritius that it would
amend its submission to take into account the Exclusive Economic Zone co-ordinates of
the Republic of Mauritius in the Chagos Archipelago region. However, despite the
undertaking given, the Government of the Republic of Mauritius notes that no
by the Republic of Maldives to amend its submission.

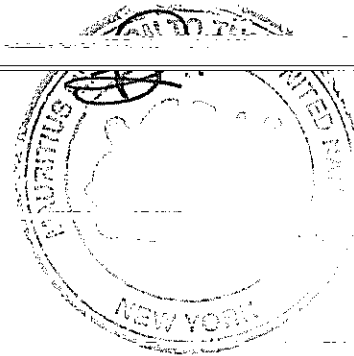
The Permanent Mission further wishes to inform the Secretary-General that the
Government of the Republic of Mauritius reiterates the sovereignty of Mauritius over
the Chagos Archipelago, including Diego Garcia, which forms an integral part of the
territory of the Republic of Mauritius under both Mauritian law and international law.
The Republic of Mauritius further stresses that the Chagos Archipelago, since 11
exercised by the United Kingdom from the territory of Mauritius prior to its
independence in violation of the UN General Assembly Resolutions 1514 (XV) of 14
December 1960, 1306 (XX) of 16 December 1965 and 1753 (LII) of 17 November 1967.

The Republic of Mauritius hereby protests formally against the submission made by the Republic of Maldives encroaches on the Exclusive Economic Zone of the Republic of Mauritius, the coordinates of which were communicated to the Secretary-General in a Note dated 20 June 2008.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Mauritius wishes to inform the Secretary-General that once the Republic of Maldives submits an addendum to amend its submission to take into account the Exclusive Economic Zone, a fresh communication will be issued.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Mauritius to the United Nations requests that its Note Verbale be circulated to all Members of the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf, all States Parties to the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea as well as Members of the United Nations.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Mauritius to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to express to the Secretary-General of the United Nations the assurances of its highest consideration.
