2. The Continental Shelf Act is amended—

(a) in section 2, by substituting a new definition of “Continental Shelf” as follows:

“ “Continental Shelf” means the sea-

areas of Trinidad and Tobago that extend beyond its territorial sea throughout the natural prolongation of its land territory to the outer edge of its Continental Margin, or to a distance of two hundred nautical miles from the baselines from which the breadth of the territorial sea of Trinidad and Tobago is measured where the outer edge of the Continental Margin does not extend up to that distance;”;

(b) by inserting in appropriate sequence the following:

“ “Continental Margin” means the submerged prolongation of the land mass of Trinidad and Tobago consisting of the seabed and subsoil, the slope and the rise of the Continental Shelf

(b) cause a copy of charts and relevant information including geodetic data, per-
