... State Parties to adopt a strong resolution that calls for the

following:

- SRHR for all! Migrants are human beings with the same basic human rights as citizens and permanent residents. The CPD resolution should call upon governments, international agencies, employers and other key stakeholders to respect, protect and promote migrants' rights, including the right to health and sexual and reproductive rights

- Upholding migrants' rights to decent work, including the right to fair wages, to change

recognising domestic work as work.

- Make available and accessible migrant-friendly legal justice and recourse at national and international levels, across and beyond borders, which includes specialised services, translation services, legal assistance, temporary shelters, and the right of migrants to stay and work during the legal process

Adopt a cross-border collaborative and multi-country approach to international
