





Caribbean regional seminar on the implementation of the Third International Decade for the Eradication of Colonialism: accelerating decolonization



This has recently been confirmed by the judgment regarding the Chagos Islands which were a part of the territory of the colony of Mauritius. UK has been told that Chagos formed part of the territorial integrity of Mauritius and should have been decolonized at the same time in 1968. Mauritius argued before the ICJ that the separation of the Chagos from Mauritius was in breach of 1514 paragraph six which specifically prohibite the breakup of colonies before independence. The independ in forces of this argument was 13 to 1. Mauritius Prime Minister said its territorial integrity would now be made
