At its 70th plenary meeting, on 14 December 2011, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee),¹⁰ taking note of the applications of states

of the Brussels Declaration of 27 November 1991, a definitive solution to the Question of Gibraltar, in the light of the relevant resolutions of the General Assembly and applicable principles, and in the spirit of the Charter of the United Nations"

(b) Took note of the desire of the United Kingdom to continue with the trilateral forum for dialogue on Gibraltar"

(c) Took note of the position of Spain that the trilateral forum for dialogue does not exist any longer and should be replaced with a new mechanism for local cooperation in which the people of the Campo de Gibraltar and Gibraltar were represented"

(d) Welcomed the efforts made by both parties to resolve current problems and to engage in a flexible and responsive form of dialogue between all relevant and appropriate parties, on an informal ad hoc basis, and that such efforts were aimed at finding common solutions and making progress on issues of mutual benefit)
