Mr. Chair,

The rule of law is essential in ensuring accobility, fighting impunity and preventing future violations. Armenia recognizes the crucial role of justice and accountability and we remain steadfast in our dedication to their pursuit.

Guided by thestrong commitment to uphology the fundamental principles of the rule of law on 16 September 2021, Armerfiked an Application with the International Court of Justice instituting proceedings against Azerbaijamder the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination (CERD), which contained as a request for the indication of provisional measures on 7 December 2021, the Countdicated first provisional measures according to which Azerbaijan shall, in accordance with its obligations under the Cerological from violence and bodily harm all persons captured in relation to the 2020 Conflict who remain in detention, and ensure their security and equality resulting law; Take all necessary measures to prevent and punish acts of vandalism and desecration affecting Armenian cultural heritage, including but not limited to churches and other places of worship, monuments, landmarks,
