



MANAGEMENT EVALUATION

- If you decide to formally contest an administrative decision that you believe has impacted you negatively and which may have violated your employment rights, the first step is to request a management evaluation. This should be done in a letter addressed to the Under-Secretary-General for Management, with a copy to the head of department or office where you work. If you work in a separately administered Fund or Programme, the letter should be addressed to the Executive Head of the Fund or Programme.

UNITED NATIONS APPEALS TRIBUNAL

- A judgement by the United Nations Dispute Tribunal can be appealed to the United Nations Appeals Tribunal by either the staff member or the administration.
- The United Nations Appeals Tribunal is also competent to hear appeals from judgements of the UNRWA Dispute Tribunal and decisions following the first instance process of UNJSP, ICAO, IMO, ISA and ITLOS.
