and I must say, commendable side, we saw an increase of some 4.8% in development assistance immediately following Monterrey. Some donor countries have reached the United Nations ODA goal of 0.7%, and have committed to reaching 1% during the period 2005 – 2006. Others have set time frames, for example, 2012, to reach 0.7%.
