The DPoAncludes a commitment to resure the fulfilment of respective ODA commitments to least developed countries, which attreprovide 0.15 to 0.2% of GNN ODA for members of the OECD DAC. This includes resources channeled through multilateral organisations on which we focus in this roundtable.

The DPoAalso notes that ODA remains crucial for financing investment for sustainable development in least developed countries, while innovative sources of finance, such as blended finance, remained limited in these countries. There is a clear need for more determined efforts by developed countries to fulfil and, where possible, enhance their relevant ODA commitments to least developed countries.
