Open briefing of the Counter-Terrorism Committee on its special meeting on countering use of new, emerging tech for terrorist purposes

New York, 1 December 2022 – On 2 December 2022, the Counter-Terrorism Committee (CTC) will hold an open briefing on its special meeting on countering the use of new and emerging technologies for terrorist purposes, held in India on 28-29 October 2022. The special meeting focused on three main areas: unmanned aerial systems, terrorist financing and information and communications technologies. The proceedings culminated with the Counter-Terrorism Committee's adoption of the Delhi Declaration, which provides guidance to Member States and stakeholders in countering terrorist use of new and emerging technologies.

The open briefing will take place at United Nations Headquarters on Friday, 2 December 2022 at 11:00 EST in Conference Room 1. The meeting will be broadcast live at <a href="http://webtv.un.org">http://webtv.un.org</a>.
