

<u>United Nations Secretary-General's Youth Advisory Group on Climate Change</u> Selection criteria for second cohort: 2023-24


The Secretary-General's Youth Advisory Group on Climate Change provides the Secretary-General with practical and outcome-focused advice, diverse youth perspectives and concrete recommendations, with a clear focus on accelerating the implementation of his Climate Action agenda.

Convened under the auspices of the UN's first-Development Goals.

The next cohort of the Youth Advisory Group will serve for a period of two years (2023-2024). The group will be selected and appointed by the Secretary-General from a pool of candidates nominated by respected youth- and climate-focused non-governmental and civil society organizations around the world.

The Group will be selected so as to reflect a wide diversity of voices from all regions of the world, and an inclusive range of life experiences, perspectives, and areas of expertise. However, as it is not possible for a seven-member group to reflect the full diversity of the global youth climate movement, the Group will be expected to consult widely across global youth networks and include perspectives from outside

 Member, founder, or leader of a youth led cli organization or programme at the global, reg level;



- Proven ability to collaborate with diverse stakeholders across the global youth climate movement;
- Strong analytic and communication skills;
- Familiarity with existing conventions, policy instruments, and/or other intergovernmental processes on climate change;
- Ability to leave organizational and country affiliations aside and serve in an individual capacity.
